As compared with other forms of dispute resolution, the mediation process can have an informal, improvisational feel. The mediation process can include some or all of the following six steps: 1. Planning. Before the mediation process begins, the mediator helps the parties decide where they should meet and who should be present.

NEGOTIATION — MEDIATION. Any Employment-Related Dispute asserted by one Party against the other Party shall be delivered in writing to the other Party.During the fifteen (15)-day period following receipt of the assertion by the other Party, the Parties shall attempt in good faith to negotiate a resolution of the Employment-Related Disputes so asserted.
