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Double Manual Harpsichord

The French double-manual harpsichord became, during the heat of the harpsichord revival of the second half of the 20th century, the basic instrument upon which much of its extensive literature was played.

2-manual Harpsichord - Early Music Studio

<p>This instrument was made by Benoist Stehlin of Paris in the mid-1700s, the golden era of French harpsichord manufacture. Austrian-born, Stehlin lived in relative obscurity, devoting his life to the building of harpsichords. This is one of three known to survive. Another (dated 1750) is at the Musée Antoine Lécuyer in St. Quentin, France, and a third (dated 1767) at the Musikinstrumenten ...

Double-manual Harpsichord This is the earliest surviving English double-manual harpsichord. Sadly nothing is known of Joseph Tisseran save his name, nor is any other instrument of his

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preserved. It is probable that he also made spinets since the soundboard grain of this instrument is, like that of a spinet, oblique to the long side.

Harpsichord Clearing House - Harpsichords, Virginals ...

Harpsichords can either come in single or double manual form, referring to the number of keyboards. Whereas the early Flemish double manual harpsichords had the two keyboards staggered in pitch in order to facilitate transposition, later models almost always were either built (rebuilt) to have the two keyboards aligned.

French Double-manual Kit We have chosen as the prototypes for our French harpsichord kit two instruments made in Paris in 1769 and 1770 by Pascal Taskin, possibly the most famous of all 18th century French makers. We made this choice because the mid-18th century French style harpsichord represents the most successful "general" purpose instrument.

Hill Franco-Flemish Double Manual Harpsichord, built in 1979 as Opus 59 then rebuilt in 2008 as Opus "416". The rebuild of this harpsichord involved replacing the soundboard, replacing the plastic jacks with pearwood jacks and new registers. This harpsichord is 8' long and has a strong yet sweet sound.

Our German double-manual harpsichords are disposed as either 2 x 8', 1 x 4', buff; or 2 x 8', 1 x 4', 1 x 16', lute, buff. The keyboards retain the proportions of the originals which are almost exactly those of the modern piano. Nevertheless, the actions are responsive and lively enough to play French music convincingly.

German double-manual harpsichords

The earliest Flemish double-manual harpsichords were designed with the keyboards pitched one fourth apart, for use as transposing instruments. They were, in effect, single-manual harpsichords capable of playing at two different pitches.
