On the basis of ancient texts, scholars generally divide the history of Egyptian language into five periods: Old Egyptian (from before 3000 to about 2200 bce), Middle Egyptian (c. 2200- c. 1600 bce), Late Egyptian (c. 1550- c. 700 bce), Demotic (c. 700 bce - c. 400 ce), and Coptic (c. 2nd century ce until at least the 17th century).
