Prior to District Office assignment, candidates must successfully complete all phases of a thirteen-week Probation and Parole Officer basic training course. This course is administered by the Department of Correction at the Employee Development Center. Coursework includes physical, classwork, and hands-on training.

Probation and Parole Officer I - State of Delaware

A parole officer and a probation officer both perform different roles. While both deal with convicted criminals, parole officers deal with criminals who have served a prison sentence. Probation officers help convicted criminals who have been granted probation—they don't have to go to prison, but they need help to keep from returning to a life of crime.

Differences Between Parole and Probation Officers

Like probationers, offenders released on parole—called “parolees”—are supervised by state-appointed parole officers and may be placed under either active or inactive supervision. As determined by the parole board, some common conditions of parole include: Reporting to a state-appointed supervisory parole officer.
