Multifetal pregnancy is associated with a significant increase in perinatal morbidity and mortality, which appears to be related directly to the number of fetuses. The mean estimated gestational age at birth is 35 weeks for twins, 33 weeks for triplets and 29 weeks for quadruplets 1 , 4 , 5 , and the risk of very preterm birth increases by almost five-fold for twins and by 20-fold for ...
